<b>Ability of Completers to be Hired</b>	
<b>Overview</b>	This evidence packet contains data of EPP completers earning education-related positions or graduate school admission. Confirmation evidence is provided by completers, typically through email communication.

<b>Trends</b>	<p><b>2022-2023 EPP Disaggregated Employment Rates Strengths:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 100% (30/30) of completers seeking education employment secured an education-related position or graduate school admission</li></ul> <p><b>2022-2023 EPP Disaggregated Employment Rates Areas of Challenge:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 100% (10/10) of completers have earned education positions in another state though the EPP is unable to officially track licensure since it is conferred by another state</li></ul> <p><b>2020-2021, 2021-2022, and 2022-2023 EPP Disaggregated Employment Rates Trends:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Over 3 cycles, 100% of completers (86/86) secured education-related positions or graduate school admission</li></ul>
<b>Future Direction</b>	<p>The EPP has established consistent cycles of high employment rates. The EPP dean, faculty, content advisor committee, and stakeholder committee continue to analyze content and pedagogy test performance annually, which is needed for licensure.</p> <p>In the summer of 2021, the State changed content and pedagogy test companies. The EPP will evaluate how the testing change impacts completer performance. In time, the EPP believes this data, which will be shared with future teacher candidate test-takers, can improve test-taking preparation and therefore, results.</p>
