TO REGISTER

1. Complete a registration form (available from your academic department), and have your advisor approve your schedule.
2. Register in Forman Hall or online for sophomores, juniors and seniors during the dates and times listed below.
3. Wait lists for full classes are not used for summer sessions. For fall semester, they are created during advance registration and are not used after April 6.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Sophomores, juniors, and seniors have the option of registering online. Academic advisors will distribute passwords. Instructions for using online registration are available at the Registrar's Office in Forman Hall and on the Web at trine.edu/academics/academic_resources/registrar/. Scroll down to "Online Resources." Each class year (sophomore, junior, senior) has a "window" for online registration which initially opens at midnight on the dates listed below and remains open through 5 p.m. on Friday, March 26. In-person registration is available between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the Registrar's Office with students registering according to their class year on the dates listed below.

TRINE UNIVERSITY ONLINE COURSES (See back for listing of fall and summer courses)

In an effort to provide greater accessibility and flexibility to students, online courses are being offered. These courses will be delivered in an eight week format.

Summer Session 1 classes will be held May 3 to June 26.
Summer Session 2 classes will be held June 28 to August 21.
Fall Session 1 classes will be held August 30 to October 23.
Fall Session 2 classes will be held October 25 to December 18.

There is a fee of \$100 per credit hour, in addition to tuition, for all online classes.

- A student must be in good academic standing to be eligible to register for an online course.
- Students may take a single online course per semester with the approval of their academic advisor during the regular academic year (fall and spring semester).

- Students may take two online courses per 8-week session with the approval of their academic advisor during the summer term.
- First-year freshmen are not eligible to enroll in an online course until after they have completed two semesters at Trine University.
