Study Abroad for Fall Semester - forms need to be completed by June $1^{\text {st }}$
Study Abroad for Spring Semester - forms need to be completed by October $15^{\text {th }}$

## Checklist

Complete the FASFA by March $1^{\text {st }}$ annually Meet with the Director of the Study Abroad program to determine if you qualify to participate in the program
Have a detailed listing of the exact costs associated with your eligible program
Meet with academic advisor to determine courses that will transfer towards degree program at Trine.
Meet with Executive Director of Financial Aid to discuss aid options available to utilize abroad Submit an "Approval to Take Courses at Another Institution" form Submit a "Study Abroad Scholarship Application" to determine if you are eligible for a Trine Scholarship to Study Abroad.

Qualifications for Study Abroad Financial Aid

- Minimum Trine cumulative GPA 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Completion of all required financial aid forms
- Proof of acceptance into the Study Abroad program
- Students are eligible for a maximum amount of aid per semester. If any of the aid exceeds the maximum costs of abroad experience then other types of awards may be reduced.
