Dependency status for financial aid purposes is typically determined by answers given to the questions in the dependency sections of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). However, a student who was initially classified as a dependent student may still be considered as an independent student for financial aid if unusual circumstances exist. A dependency override is not taken lightly by the Department of Education and detailed documentation provided by you is critical. If you (the student) believe you might qualify for a dependency override, please read through this entire form before starting the appeal and provide documentation to support your unusual circumstance.

Any letter submitted as documentation should be on letterhead or notarized if letterhead is not available. It should include the following: The length of time and the nature of the writer's relationship to you. The reason why you cannot provide your parents' information on the FAFSA. **Step 4: Additional Documentation** You may always include additional information to further explain your basis for appeal. Examples are: Your current employment records, pay stubs and bank statements. Any additional documentation to verify information in your letter.
