## Trine University Main Campus Facts

- 1,766 degree-seeking undergraduates
- 70 percent of undergraduates were from Indiana
- Average gift aid per student was \$19,991
- Average aid from all sources per student was \$28,200
- Trine's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) priority filing deadline is March 1
- School code: 001839

## About Trine University undergraduate financial aid

- 96 percent of undergraduate students received financial aid
- 1,590 students received merit scholarships from Trine
- More than \$27 million in scholarship assistance was awarded from Trine resources
- Trine's financial aid budget continued to grow faster than tuition
- 384 students received state grant aid
- 356 students received outside scholarships
- More than \$65 million was awarded from all sources of financial aid: federal, state and institutional — grants, loans, work-study and scholarships
