



Cost of Attendance Worksheet

The total cost of attendance is unique for each student at each school. While some expenses are fixed (like tuition and fees) **others are influenced and controlled by the student**. All financial aid funds are first applied to the students "direct costs" for attending Trine University. Families must also plan for paying "indirect costs" unique to you (e.g. off-campus housing, books, transportation, misc. expenses, etc.) This worksheet was designed to assist you in determining your total out of pocket costs. You will need to reference your MyTrineFA account online at mytrinefa.trine.edu for specific aid and trine.edu/costs for a list of costs. **NOTE: THIS WORKSHEET IS FOR YOUR USE AND DOES NOT NEED TO BE RETURNED TO THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE.**
