

Identity and Statement of Educational Purpose

To Be Signed at the Institution



Your FAFSA was selected for a review process called “verification”. The Department of Education randomly selects the FAFSA’s chosen for verification and not Trine University. Because Trine University administers federal financial aid programs we are required to request, collect, and verify information submitted through the FAFSA and adjust or cancel aid accordingly. It is the student’s responsibility to comply in a timely manner with all requests for documentation. Trine does not take responsibility for changes made to financial aid when paperwork is submitted late. For an accurate bill it is best to submit the requested paperwork as soon as you are able to. Every time you submit a FAFSA you have a chance of being selected for verification.

This is your first option, if you cannot come to Trine University or one of our branch campuses, please contact the Financial Aid Office at 800.347.4878.

The student must appear in person at Trine University to verify his or her identity by presenting an unexpired valid government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to, a driver’s license, other state-issued ID, or passport. The institution will maintain a copy of the student’s photo ID that is annotated with the date it was received and the name of the official at the institution authorized to collect the student’s ID.

In addition, the student must sign, in the presence of the institutional official, the following:
