



## Trine University Main Campus Facts

Based on 2019-20 school year

- 2,014 degree-seeking undergraduates
- 70 percent of undergraduates live on campus
- Average gift aid per student is \$22,485
- Average aid from all sources per student is \$35,235

## Trine University Undergraduate Financial Aid

- 95 percent of undergraduate students received financial aid
- 1,992 students received merit scholarships from Trine
- More than \$36 million in scholarship assistance was awarded from Trine resources
- 474 students received state grant aid
- 458 students received outside scholarships
- More than \$68 million was awarded from all sources of financial aid: federal, state and institutional — grants, loans, work-study and scholarships

## Federal Aid Awarded to Trine Students

- 605 students received Pell grants
- 512 students participated in the federal work-study program
- 1,288 students received subsidized Stafford direct loans
- 1,397 students received unsubsidized Stafford direct loans
- 414 students benefited from parent (PLUS) loans

# Academic Tuition Scholarships

A student may receive ONE Trine academic tuition scholarship. The scholarship of greater value will be awarded. Renewal requirements may vary by award. These scholarships are for undergraduate tuition only.

* President's Scholarship	\$16,000 per year
* Distinguished Scholarship	\$14,000 per year
* Dean's Scholarship	\$13,000 per year
* University Scholarship	\$11,000 per year
* Discovery Award	\$8,000 per year

Students who choose to be Test Optional for admission could be eligible for a merit based scholarship ranging between \$9-\$12,000

## Indiana State Grants

Indiana's Division of Student Financial Aid (SFA) determines eligibility for the Frank O'Bannon Grant (Higher Education and Freedom of Choice) and Twenty-First Century Scholarship.

## How to Apply for Financial Aid

There are several pieces of information we need in order to get you the most financial aid possible.

1. Apply for admission
2. Be accepted into degree-seeking program as an eligible student at the main campus.
3. Get your FSA ID – you need this to begin your FAFSA
4. Complete the FAFSA (available Oct. 1) by the March 1 deadline. This is to be completed annually. Our school code for the FAFSA is 001839.



## Other Tuition Awards

**Important:** Stackable Awards, (limit of two), are used to meet student need and may be combined with an academic tuition scholarship, and may not exceed the cost of tuition.
