



Campus Safety –Emergency Notifications

Trine University uses Rave Mobile Alerts to notify students, faculty and staff of all emergencies that might occur on or around the campuses. This mass notification system sends alerts for situations of severe weather, medical emergencies and other types of crisis situations. Notifications will be sent through text and email in addition to Facebook and twitter accounts when appropriate. Staff members will also receive an “Alert US” message on their work computers when an alert is issued.

Go to www.getrave.com/login/trine to set up your account. This is a free service and it is recommended that all students and their families, along with faculty and staff sign up for this alert notification system.

To set up your account and log in, use the first part of your email address as your user name (the section before the @trine.edu). The same credential you use to log into myportal on the Trine website or check your email and log into your computers. After you enter your password, click “log in”. You will then be able to add your mobile phones and test your email and other mobile accounts. Make sure to select your campus location, click on the “Groups” tab and search through “Official Groups” section. Click on the Trine University location you wish to receive notifications for. Once the location is selected simply click “Join” under group status. You will then be enrolled to receive notifications for that specific location.
