  - o Some of the policies the regional fairs need to enforce include ensuring prior approvals for projects involving vertebrate animals, potentially hazardous biological agents, hazardous chemicals, and human subjects. Requiring students to gather all appropriate signatures on their forms. An **Institutional Review Board (IRB)** is a committee that, according to federal regulations (45-CFR-46), must evaluate the potential physical and/or psychological risk of research involving humans. All proposed human research must be reviewed and approved by an IRB before experimentation begins. This includes review of any surveys or questionnaires to be used in a project. We have added members to our Scientific Review Committee and created an Institutional Review Board for the regional fair-names at the bottom of page.

All Divisions: On the SEFI web site, registrations must include:

Address, phone, grade, date of birth, project title, and category.

Research plan and brief abstract must be included in online entry.

Student/Parent Email required (may be the teacher if student does not have access to email).

Do not use a school email.

Check the box to indicate whether your display needs electricity.

Gender and ethnicity is requested, option available if you decline to answer.

<u>Human Consent Form</u> – if humans are part of the project this form must be completed and uploaded in Sefi.org with project.
